Remove the Timing Belt and Pulleys. Unbolt and remove the Timing Belt Tension Pulley (left side of the engine). Using a box wrench, slightly move clockwise (1 degree) the Camshaft Pulley and remove the belt. This slight advance in the camshaft will allow some belt slack to ease new belt installation.

Timing belts must be replaced at the manufacturer's recommended distance and/or time periods. Failure to replace the belt can result in complete breakdown or catastrophic engine failure. Stripped teeth leave a smooth section of belt where the drive cog will slip. Delaminating and unraveling of the belt's fiber cores.

Removing the lower timing cover is a bit of a bear, mostly because of two bolts-- one behind the serpentine belt tensioner, it's not too bad. Take the belt tensioner pulley off, put bolt back on, then pull the bolt to the side with a ratchet and pop the torx out with your impact.
